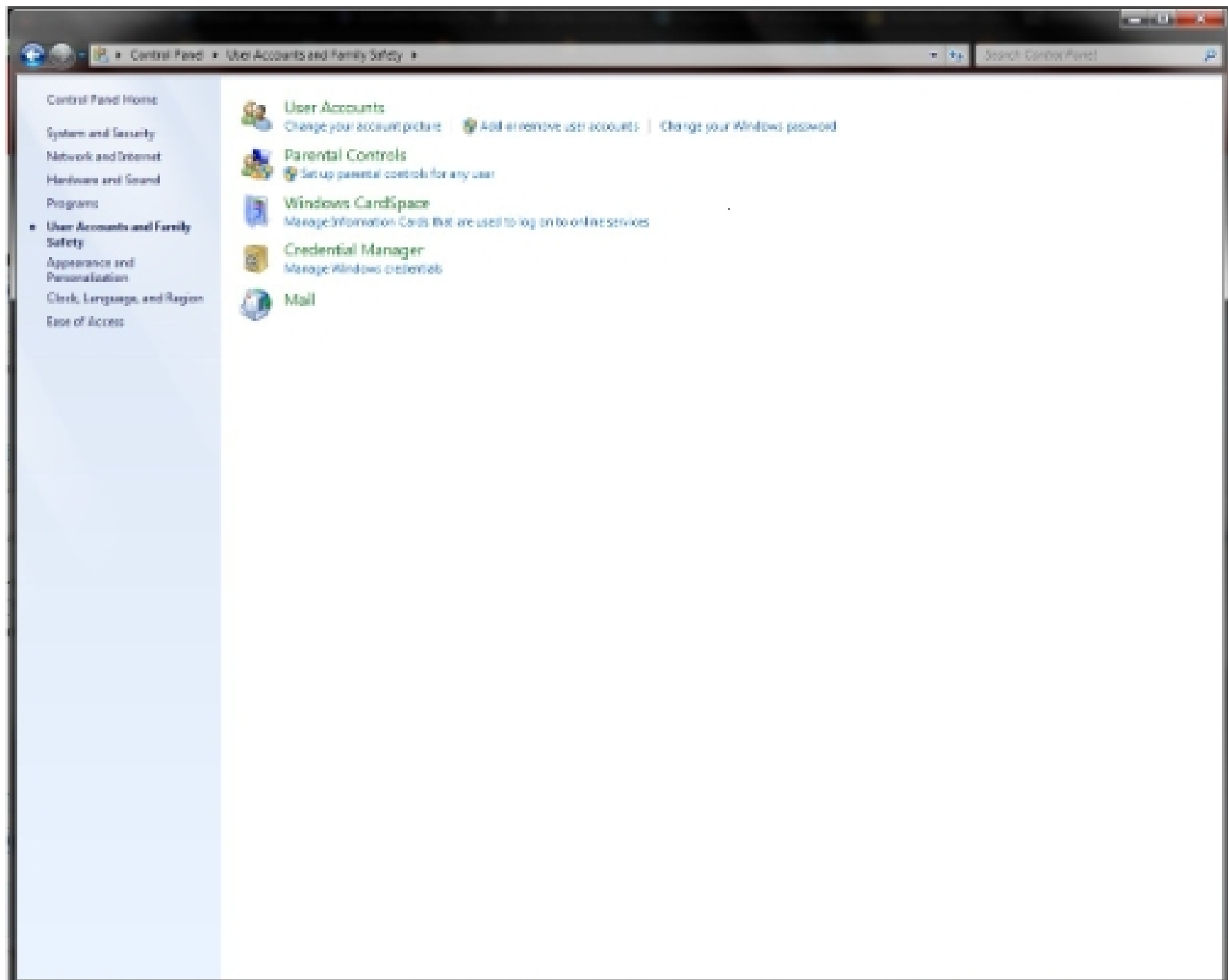

### **Secure a Windows PC from Unauthorized Local Use:**

In this scenario I am assuming it means you are adding parental controls to your home computer to prevent use of programs you do not wish children to use, and prevent your computer from being used by people you do not want to use it.

1. Click your start menu.
2. Find and click on "Control Panel" located towards the bottom right side of your start menu.

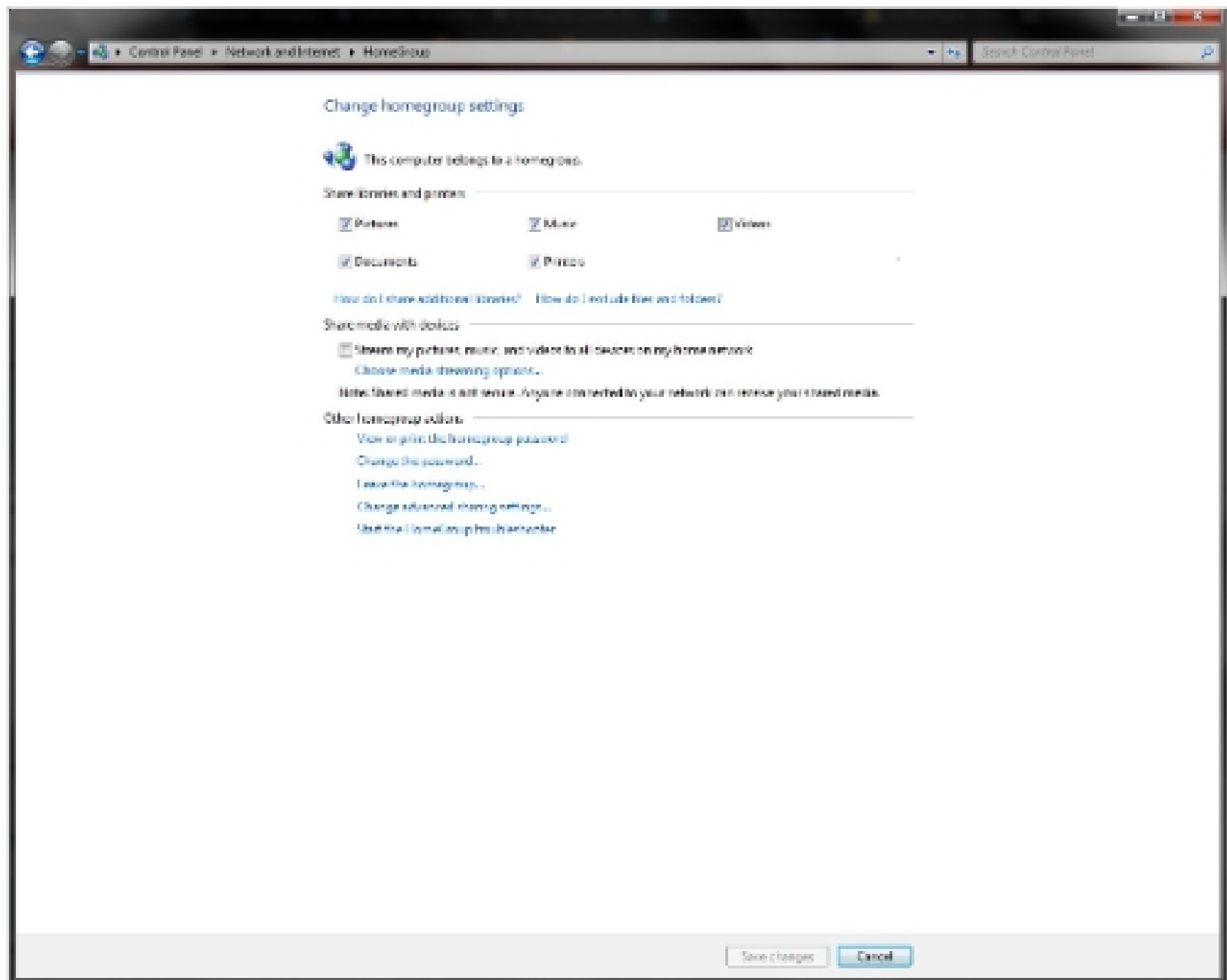
3. Find and click on "User Accounts and Family Security". (Top right option)
4. After you click on this you should see something that looks like this.



5. Using this menu you can set a password for your computer required to log in and use your computer. You can also set up parental controls to limit programs and limit computer usage by time ect.

### **Create a Windows 7 HomeGroup:**

1. Click on your start button.
2. Click on "Control Panel" located towards the bottom right of the menu.
3. Click on "Network and Internet"
4. After you click on "Network and Internet" the second option you see appear in the box allows you to choose a Windows 7 HomeGroup and sharing options.



### Share Folders in Windows 7:

The creation of a Windows 7 HomeGroup allows you to select certain types of folders you would like to be seen by other computers on your HomeGroup, but if you wish to add additional folders to be seen by other computers of your group then follow these steps.

1. Using Windows 7 they made this very easy, all you have to do is open the folder you wish to share.
2. Click on the "Share With" button as shown in this picture.
