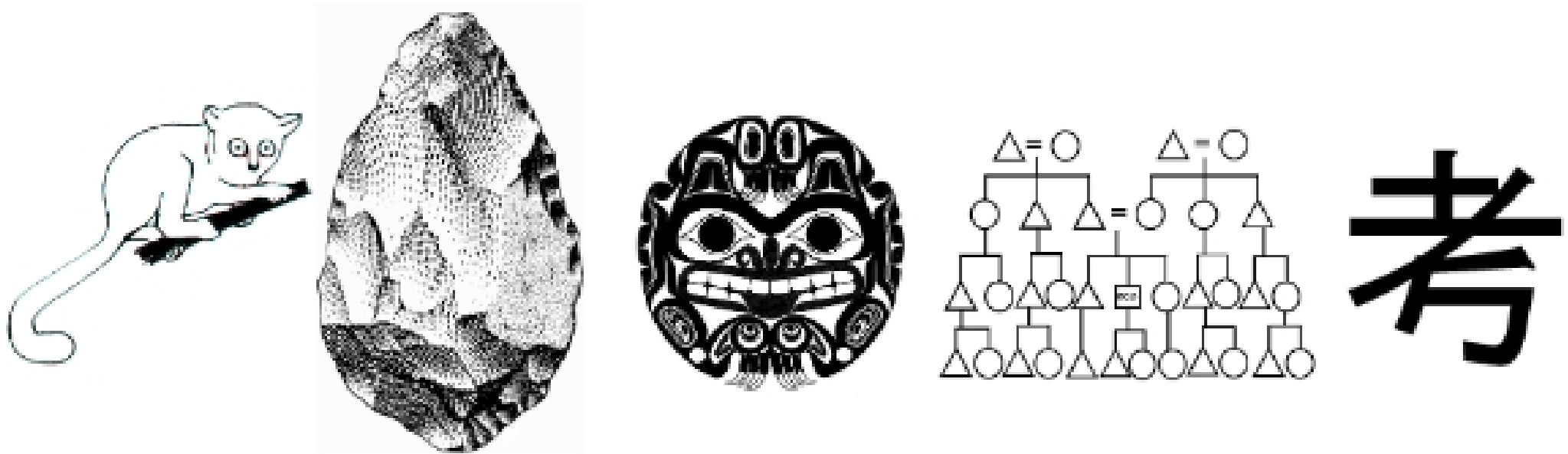

Biological Anthropology



- Also called Physical Anthropology
- The biology and evolution of the morphological and behavioral traits of humans and their close relatives

Biological Anthropology

- Principles
 - Molecular biology overview (DNA, protein synthesis, genes)
 - Evolution, with an emphasis on *natural selection* (the type of evolution that produced the adaptations that all organisms, including humans, have)
 - Synthesis of the principles
