

- Oaxaca Barrio
 - It was known they were foreigners
 - 12 ethnic neighborhoods
 - 12 apartments
 - 700 people
 - All buried on their back and laid out
 - Sample of 56 burials
 - All from Oaxaca
 - Initial founders from Oaxaca
 - Later immigrants from Oaxaca
 - Children moving around a lot with mother
 - Ex. 409 born in Teotihuacan move to Oaxaca then return
 - 80% of burial population immigrants or born in Teotihuacan but spent part of childhood elsewhere

Malaria

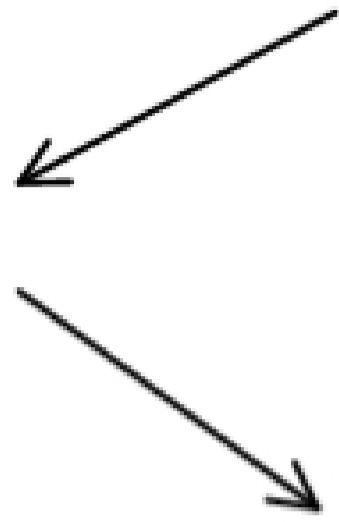

Children move around with mother

- Oaxaca Barrio
 - Initial founders from Oaxaca
 - Later immigrants from Oaxaca and Oaxaca colonies elsewhere
 - Children moving around a great deal (with mother)



- Positions of leadership
Open to all
 - Egalitarian (bands tribes)
 - Leadership based on achievement
 - achieved status
 - everyone "equal" at birth
-
- Positions of leadership restricted
 - Inegalitarian (rank, chiefdoms)
 - on genealogy
 - ascribed status (born into)
 - some already privileged at birth
