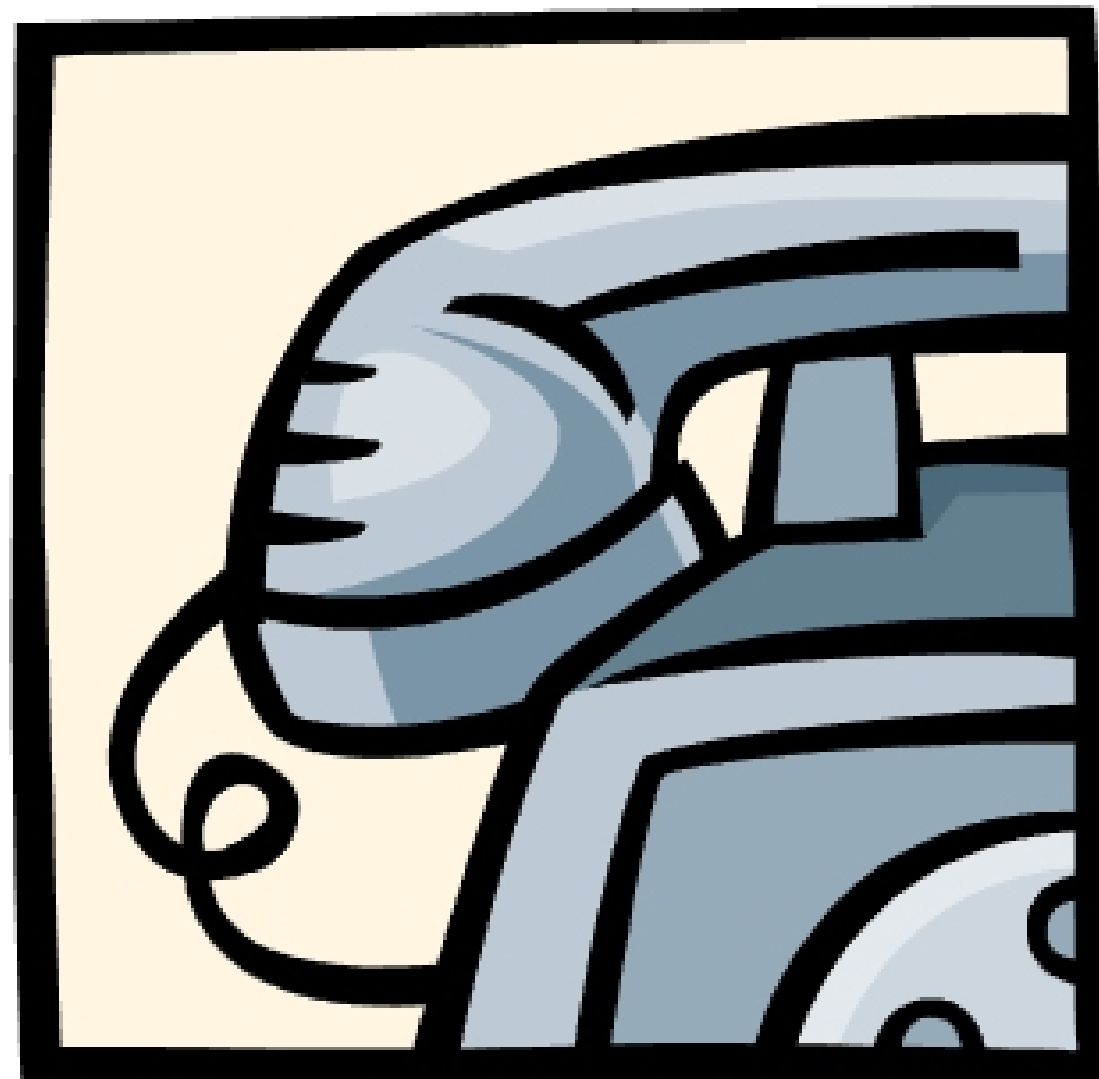


# VoiceXML Basic COCOMO Calculator

The 'XML' in VoiceXML stands for:

## **E***X*tensible *M*arkup *L*anguage

- XML is a meta-markup language, a set of rules for creating semantic tags used to describe data.
- An XML element is made up of a start tag, an end tag, and data in between.
- The start and end tags describe the data within the tags, which is considered the value of the element.

# VoiceXML takes this a step further, to the world of telephony!

Several voice browser providers: TellMe, Pipebeach, VoiceGenie, BeVocal, etc.

➤ **Most** let you sign up for free or a nominal charge, provided your application is small.

➤ **Most** come with file management, a text editor and even a VoiceXML validator
