The CWE gave me the most feedback informed me of run-on sentences, contractions and the proper use for them, the use of second person in an academic writing, the use of that and it and the proper way to use it, and the elimination of colloquial language in my academic writing. My instructor gave me advice on my introduction and conclusion I did not receive feedback on my paper or did not receive a peer review because my assignment was turned in late and I don't think my paper was reviewed by my peers. This puts me at a great disadvantage because I only got feedback from one source. If I follow the instructions and revision information given to me by the CWE then I should be fine. I just believe that if I had feedback from more than one source then that could help me out tremendously. I will take the feedback I received from the CWE and incorporate it in my writing.

I will try not to make the same mistakes. I will also make sure that my punctuation and grammar is up to par. I have quite a few run-on sentences and a couple of places in my writing where the use of third person should have been. These are common mistakes for me and I will try to be more careful when revising and finishing my essay. I want to make sure that I follow all the feedback that was given because this is credible feedback from a credible source. My only disadvantage as I stated before was that I was not able to have a real instructor review and a peer review. If I had all three, I could make a better and lengthy decision on the proper revisions for my writing.
