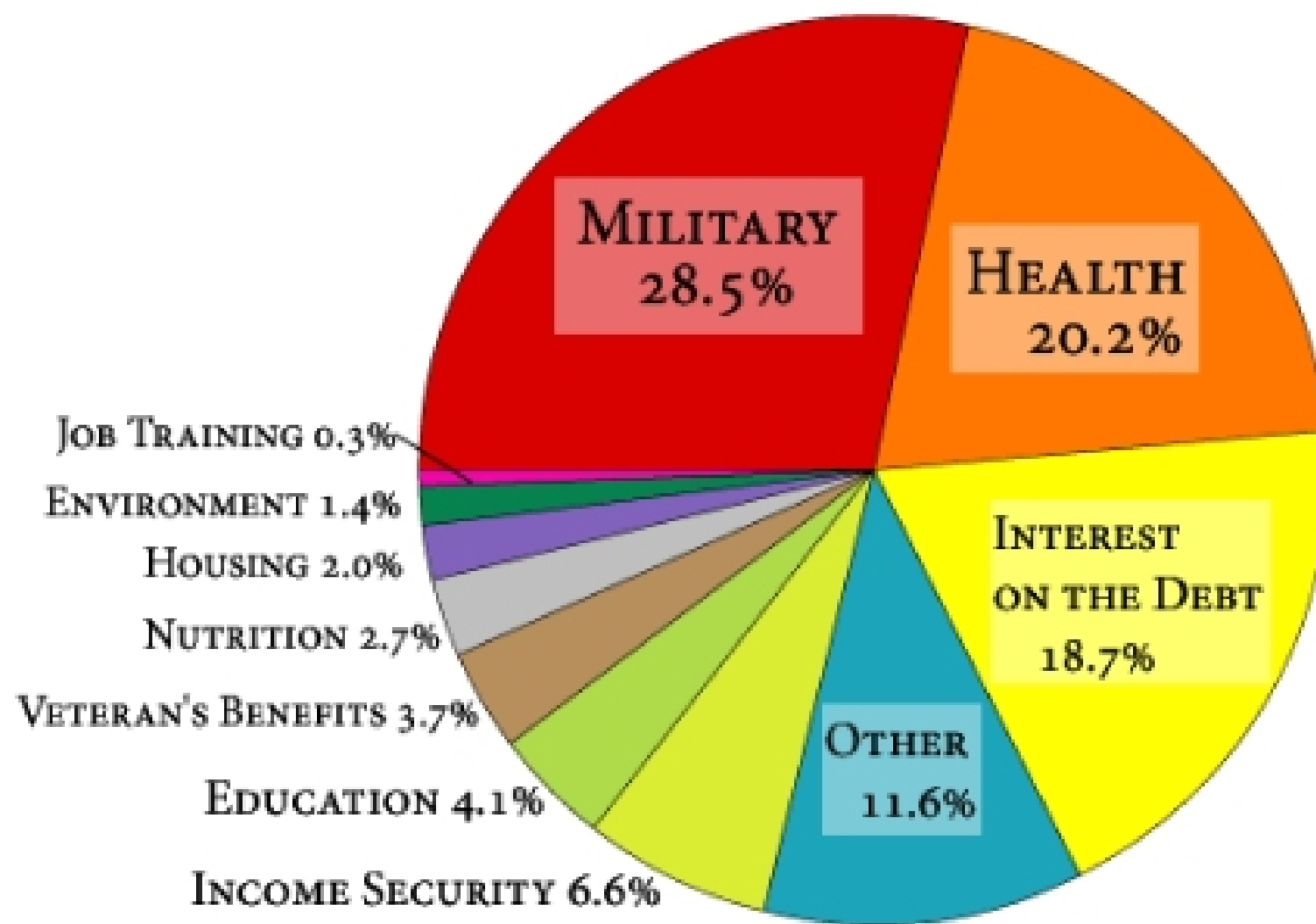
NPP INCOME TAX CHART
