Core of art is about being human

Things of art Occupies some space and time and has a form, adds a presence to our senses

Intended for human communication is has content

**Content/Form** can't be separated to be art

Gestalt- unified whole is more than the sum of its parts

Ex. Gestalt- cookies has flour salt etc. Is content but is doesn't have the form the cookie made all together

**Aesthetic-** framework for perception or the outline of our way of dealing with the world

**Abstract-** reduce things to their elemental core or to theorize

If you change the form you change the content

**Realism-** just a style, not necessarily truthful or authentic,

**Verisimilitude-** way to describe or the degree of how something appears to true or truthful

Ex. King of hill (more real) to Simpsons to south park (less and less real)

Things don't have to be realistic to be truthful
