

Validity

- Types of validity (facets of construct validity)
 - Convergent Validity: measure is related to other measures it theoretically should be related to
 - > Ex: measure of depression be:
 - positively related to the measure of negative mood
 - negatively related to measure of self-esteem
 - Discriminant validity: measure does not relate to other measures it theoretically should not relate to
 - > Ex: measure of depression should not be related to measure of spatial ability
