Population Genetics

- The study of patterns of genetic variation
- Species
 - A species of organisms capable of interbreeding.
- Gene pool
 - Collection of all alleles present in all individuals in a species.
- Populations
 - Interbreeding groups of organisms of the same species living in the same geographical area.
