I. Preparatory Remarks

- Biogenic-psychogenic dichotomy (two different theories that say what caused the disorders)
 - Biological disorders (Alzheimer's)
 - Psychogenic: anxiety
- Problems of Diagnosis
 - Fred McKinney-Sara J.
 - Fred-Health-Clinic University of Missouri (12 in 12 years)
 - Sara- 4 in one morning
 - Opinions
 - ADHD/Bipolar
 - Over diagnosed
 - Two options (Annie M.)
 - Runner (hip replacement)
 - Too often eye of the beholder
 - Human error
- Do we need diagnostic system at all?
 - RESPONSIBLE
 - IRRESPONSIBLE

- o ICD 4 (international classification of disorders)

II. Statistics of Diagnosis Disorders (DSM I-V)

- 1952:60
- 1968: 150 (by these last two, being gay was a disorder)
- 1980: 250
 - o wanted to revoke the fact gay was a disorder (1975)
- 1987: 300+
- 1994: 400+
- 2013: 400+

III. DSM V:

- Obsessive compulsive & related disorders:
 - o OCD
 - o Hoarding
 - o Body Dysmorphic Disorder
 - People don't feel like their body is in synch with rest of their being
 - o Trichotillomania
 - People who pull their hair out
 - o Skin Picking Disorder
- Pedophilia is now "Pedohebephilic disorder"
- "Major Neurocognitive disorder" replaces: Dementia

IV. State Tax- Supported treatment programs

- 1965 Texas department of health
- 2004 Texas Department of mental health and mental retardation (TDMHMR)
- Now, DSH/DADS serves 254 Texas counties
 - DSH- mental illness
 - DADs- ageing and disability services, mental retardation
- 10 mental health hospitals
- 13 State supported living centers 88yh
- 41 community mental health/mental retardation centers
 - keeping people out of mental hospitals
 - taking care of them when they're released
 - mexia (meh-hay-uh)

V. Mental Health Professionals

- Psychiatrists
 - MD degree, began 1840, 35,000, median age: 52, 75% male
75%white
- Psychologists
 - PHD/PSYD/EDD, began late 1940's. around 70,000 currently, median age:48, 23% male, 77% female, clinical/counseling/school
 - EDD is old an outdated program
- APA Approval
 - 255 programs in US
 - 190 clinical
 - 65 counseling
