Your Arsenal of Tools

- Logs! - But you have to understand them
- Command piping
 - Send `stdout` of one program to another's `stdin`
- `grep` – Find matching patterns in text
- `last` – See who last logged in
 - And the date and their IP address
- `find` – Find files owned by a user
- `lsof` – LiSt Open Files
 - Everything in unix/linux is a file!!

Command Piping

- Redirecting `STDOUT` of one program to `STDIN` of another
- Gives you the ability to chain many commands together to accomplish a task
