SOCIAL WORLDS

Howard S. Becker

- sociologist or jazz musician
- smoked weed
- wrote a book called Art Worlds
 - includes artists
 - galleries
 - museums
 - critics
 - stores that supply artists
 - factories
 - (a whole "world" that supports the artist)

Segmentation

- civil war reenactors- dress up like civil war soldiers
- wanted something more realistic
- very specific

Hardcore reenactor

- committed to authenticity
- ate real civil war food

"Farbs" - don't take reenacting seriously

- not authentic
- over time there is segmentation

Barbershop quartet

- romanticized vision of the past

Vocal Spectrum
