Works for Child's Advocacy Center is a place where kids can come and tell their story of abuse/neglect one time and not have to tell their story multiple times to many different people for free.

Run safety education program: teach kids what are good touches and bad touches and what is a good secret or bad secret.

Child abuse is very big:

- 1 in 3 girls have been abused in our country
- 1 in 6 boys have been abused in our country
- 20 percent of abuse is by kids to other kids
- Primarily people you know and usually male like father, brother, friends of the family, babysitters

Get referral from pediatricians, Child Services, court, and some walk in by themselves, but most are from Child Services

He only gets four sessions with the kids

With the crisis counseling it is usually between 8-12 sessions
