Definition	Type of IV Equipment
1. A kind of electronic infusion pump	<u>Syringe pump</u>

4. Hypodermic injection into a vein	<u>Direct IV injection</u>
5. Devices often referred to as electronic flow clamps	<u>Controller</u>
6. Device that maintains flow by displacing fluid at an ordered rate	<u>Infusion pump</u>
7. D ₂ W	<u>Dextrose in water</u>
8. Quantity of IV fluid that can be run over a period of time	<u>IV bolus</u>
9. Replaces fluids and maintains electrolytes	<u>Continuous IV infusion</u>
10. Medications dissolved in a small amount of IV fluid	<u>IVPB</u>
