Parenting Styles

- Authoritarian parenting:
 - Restrictive, punitive style in which parents exhort the child to follow their directions and respect their work and effort
 - “Totalitarian”, one way road
- Authoritative parenting:
 - Encourages children to be independent but still places limits and controls on their actions
 - Compromising, two way street

Parenting Styles

- Neglectful parenting:
 - Parent is uninvolved in the child's life
 - parents needs and wants come first
- Indulgent parenting:
 - Parents are highly involved with their children but place few demands or controls on them
 - no rules or punishments
