

1. Saptapadi: This is the most significant ritual of the Rasar marriage ceremony, where the couple takes seven steps around the sacred fire, representing their vows and promises to each other for a lifelong companionship.
2. Sindoor: The groom applies sindoor, a red vermillion powder, on the bride's forehead or parting of the hair, symbolizing her married status.
3. Ashirvad: The ceremony concludes with blessings and well-wishes from the elders and the priest, seeking the blessings of the deities for a happy and prosperous married life.

Apart from these main rituals, there may be several other customs and traditions followed in Rasar marriages, such as exchange of garlands, blessings from the family deities, performance of cultural dances, and elaborate feasts for the guests.
