- The AutoNumber data type stores an integer that Access increments (adds to) automatically as you add new records.
- You can use the AutoNumber data type as a unique record identification (usually primary key) for tables having no other unique value or no other more proper primary key candidates.

- Similar to that Access supports autonumber, Oracle allows you to create counters called **sequences** that increment each time they are used.
- **In MSSQL, the similar concept is identity,** much easier than Oracle.
