- A tool for aggregating and managing web content.
- A user customizable view of these Web content pieces.
- Implemented on top of standard services.
- A way to accomplish tasks through browsers:
 - Launch, monitor jobs
 - Move files
 - Run science applications based on these services.
- Compatible with emerging standards and best practices (such as portlets, JSR 168 and WSRP).
