COPYRIGHT LAW: TIME FOR AN OVERHAUL

I like the idea of *copyrights*: They protect the content of this (and every other) magazine and of the books I (and others) write. They help create and protect my job and my living. Yet what Lessig says is as true as it is provocative: Overuse of *copyrights* has turned a simple and useful system for fostering innovation into one that cramps and constricts it.

This is especially important for *computer* users, as the intangible code and data we use, create, adapt, adopt, and maybe even sell to others is becoming the new gold. And it's as important to corporate IT people as to the gamer punching away in the dark at 2:00 a.m. Unless we can reenvision a broader, sharper, more nuanced system for protecting creators'—and users'—rights than we have right now, piracy and abuse of those rights on both sides are going to spin out of control, probably irreversibly.
