

Criminal Justice 320 Exam 1 Review

- **Deterrence Model:**
 - o The idea that rational human beings will not commit crimes if they know that the pain of punishment will outweigh the pleasure of committing the crime.
 - o Form of preventing crime

- **General Deterrence:**
 - o Aims, by the threat of punishment, to prevent the general population who haven't committed crimes from doing so.

- **Special/Specific Deterrence:**
 - o Aims, by punishing already convicted offenders, to prevent them from committing any more crimes in the future.
