

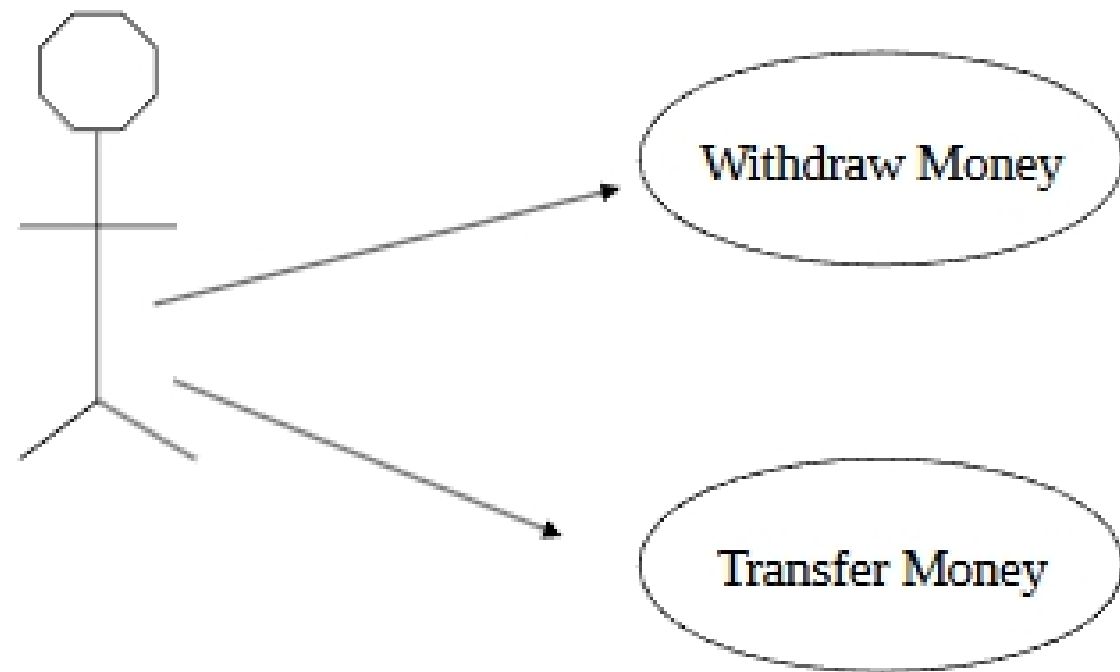

Extending the UML with Stereotyping

- Know we have 'Change' in everything.
- Extend UML? Built in feature!
 - extend UML for new 'types' ; New types of model elements!
 - allows customization of models for project
- **Stereotypes** allow 'refine' / 'reclassify' 're-specify' **all** model elements into a more specialized form **rather than** create additional symbols!
- Example: might specify a Use Case as a <<mission critical>> or class name with the stereotype: <<boundary>> or <<control>> etc.
- Most common UML stereotyped element is the class.
- Stereotyping makes these different model elements!!!
