Functions

- System insures continual existence of human species
- ONLY system NOT essential to survival of the individual
- Produces, stores, nourishes, and transports functional female and male reproductive cells called **gametes**

Male Reproductive System

- Identify and/or label the following components of the male reproductive system:
- Penis (shaft, glans, prepuce), testes, epididymis, ductus deferens, seminal vesicles, bulbourethral gland, prostate gland, urethra, and ejaculatory duct
