# Grading Summary of Short Report #2

- 87/132 students submitted the report
  - 59 reports got a 10
  - 16 reports got a 9
  - 3 reports got an 8
  - 6 reports got a 7
  - 3 reports got a 6
- The most common mistake was forgetting to give a personal view of the lecture, for which I took 1 point off
- The reason some students got below a 7 was the same as last time; they made many grammar mistakes and then also made another mistake such as forgetting the cover sheet or not giving their personal view of the lecture.
- So many students did NOT submit a report.
